




VULNERABILITIES IDENTIFIED FROM MAY 24 TO MAY 30, 2021

IDENTIFIED VULNERABILITIES BY CVSS SCORE



The identified vulnerabilities must be fixed to maintain a good cybersecurity hygiene and protect your network system from malware attacks. Organizations should take a risk-based approach to correct these types of vulnerabilities, starting with the most critical ones (rated 10), followed by those rated 9, 8, 7, etc., until all vulnerabilities rated 4.0 through 10.0 are corrected.

The vulnerability classified as "LOW RISK" are not required to be fixed to pass compliance, however, Organizations are encouraged to correct these vulnerabilities.
